

Sea Monster Has Quills, Hair And Head of Horse

**MARINE FREAK HAS HIGH-
BROWS PUZZLED — BACK-
BONE ONLY BONE**

RUPERT. Nov. 22.—The remains of a strange marine monster, possibly a sea serpent, are being studied by Dr. Neal Carter, director of the Rupert Dominion Fisheries Experimental Station. They were found on the beach of Henry Island and brought here, partly decomposed.

Carter announced it was about 30 feet long with red flesh and a head somewhat like a horse and tough, rough skin. The upper part of the skin bore hair and the lower part quills, like spines. The only bone of importance was the backbone.
